He also worked to enhance collaboration and program development with institutions of higher learning to close the achievement gaps within the Native Hawaiian college student population.

“We welcome Hanale Vincent to Springdale Preparatory School and look forward to his leadership and direction in guiding our boarding program as dean of student culture and international services,” says Johnny Graham, founding head of school. “He has extensive boarding school experience with added experience in curriculum development and career counseling. Vincent earned a Master’s degree in social work with a child and family concentration from the University of Hawaii at Manoa in Honolulu and a Bachelor of Science degree in sociology from Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah. He is a School Wide Information Systems (SWIS) Certified Facilitator (PBIS), a Career Development Facilitator (NCDA) and a Certified High School Coach.
