



Dear Springdale Preparatory School Families,

In order to comply with Maryland state laws regarding distribution of medication to students at Springdale, we will need some additional documentation from you and your child's doctor. It is required that we have a doctor's order to allow us to dispense any medication to students. This includes prescription **AND** any over the counter medicines that your child has used previously, or may need in the future. Asthma inhalers/treatments are also required to be accompanied by a doctor's order.

In these orders, doctors must provide an order that provides guidance regarding dosage, frequency, and type of medication. A list of approved medication is not sufficient for us to distribute medication to students, please make sure that your child's doctor clearly outlines the orders for your child.

For example, an order might read as follows, "Tylenol 650mg po every 6 hours as needed for a headache." These **SPECIFIC** orders will allow myself and designated trained staff at Springdale to provide these medicines as needed for your child.
