

Springdale's Safety and Cleaning Protocol

- Every student and staff must practice personal hygiene all the time.
 - Keep six feet apart
 - Wear masks
 - Frequent disinfecting of high touch surfaces
 - Wash hands
 - Limit the use of shared equipment & school supplies
 - Temperature check before entering the school building
- Each day, custodians provide regular cleaning, sanitizing, and disinfecting during and after school time to the entire school building - including but not limiting to classrooms, break rooms, general/private offices, lobby, hallways, restrooms, gym, cafeteria, and all entrance areas.
- Hospital-grade disinfectant cleaning supplies to be used:
 - Kaivac No-Touch Cleaning System
 - Victory Electrostatic Sprayer, using an electrostatic applicator, giving a negative charge to the TB-Cide Quat disinfecting solution.
 - TB-Cide Quat is a ready-to-use virucidal cleaner and disinfectant for use in hospitals, nursing homes, schools, etc., where infection control is of prime importance. TB-Cide Quat is EPA registered.
- Isolated medical room for staff/student showing symptoms.
- Short closings to allow for disinfecting by a specialized COVID cleaning crew in case of a confirmed case.
- Transition to online instruction in the event of further outbreaks.
